Re: Updated Member Hockey Policies for 2020/2021 Season

MASKS MANDATORY

Effective immediately, all individuals entering the NSWC (players, parents, coaches) MUST be wearing a mask. This includes the dressing rooms.

Masks are not mandatory for players while on the ice or on the bench.

DRESSING ROOMS

While in dressing rooms, the following number of players are allowed in each dressing room.

- Room #1: 8 players
- Room #2: 9 players
- Room #3: 7 players
- Room #4: 7 players
- Room #5: 7 players
- Room #6: 7 players
- Room #7: 9 players
- Room #8: 8 players
- Room #11: 11 players
- Room #12: 6 players
- Family Dressing Room: 11 players
- HTC Dryland Area: 30 players

If players are 10 and under, only TWO parents, wearing masks, at a time may be allowed in the dressing room to tie skates if necessary. Other parents must wait outside the room, in face masks and socially distance.

ARRIVAL

ALL Minor Hockey Players must arrive fully dressed, no earlier than 20 minutes prior to their ice time. We ask that all players 10 and under, wear their skates with skate guards to limit the need for additional people in each dressing room.

VIEWING AREA (inside and by ice rinks)

Viewing areas are closed by a VCH order until further notice. That means no parents/members in any viewing indoor areas or out by the ice rink.

The Team Manager/Safety Person will be permitted to be rink side for assistance for U9 – U6 teams only. Masks and appropriate physical distancing is in effect at all times.

EXITING THE BUILDING

Immediately following your ice time, players can remove their skates, helmet and gloves, and then must proceed to the nearest exit. If members would like to access the club for further amenities, please return through the front entrance.

From all Hockey Hallway dressing rooms and HTC Change areas parents and players are to exit the building via the Tennis stairwell (across from room 8) then across the tiki deck to main Club exit.

MEMBER ACCESS TO CLUB

Members will continue to have access to the Food & Beverage services and other Club amenities.

If ANY of the above protocols are not followed, you will be denied entry into the NSWC or asked to leave immediately.
