



NSWC 2023 Active Alumni Program

Purpose:

This program is offered from May 1st to August 31st yearly and has been developed in order to maintain professional training relationships with athletes who have worked through the grass roots of their sport at the NSWC and who are now playing at a higher level than the Club offers, en-route to a pro-career or post-secondary education.

Eligible Players:

- 1. Must have played minor hockey at the North Shore Winter Club
- 2. Is currently on a Jr A roster or above
 - A player developing in order to make a Jr A roster, or above, will be considered by the Director of Hockey as a possible participant.
 - BCHL/CJHL (or provincial equivalent), CHL, USports, NCAA.

Program Includes:

An option to participate in Alumni Skates held at the club Monday-Friday in June, July & August.
